Brigg remembers....

Over the week-end of 11th – 13th November Brigg again paid its respects – to all those who have given their lives in wars and conflict throughout the world. The week-end began on Friday 11th November with the Children's Service at the War Memorial, when pupils from our three Primary Schools came together to share readings and prayers which they had written themselves, and to plant the Crosses of Remembrance. This service has quickly become a firm fixture within the Town's Calendar and, as always, was a most moving occasion.

The Brigg A.T.C. Band and the Brigg Army Cadets escorted the parade which included veterans, and ex-servicemen and woman, the Town Mayor and Consort of Brigg, members of Brigg Town Council (Councillor A. Sykes also representing the Royal Navy), Ian Cawsey MP, North Lincolnshire Ward Councillors, J. Berry and N. Sherwood, as well as the representative(s) of the Brigg Servicemens Club, St. John Ambulance, Red Cross, Police and Fire Service, Scouts, Guides, Girls Brigade, Brigg W.I., and Brigg Lions.

*In a climate where young people are so often criticised, we take the opportunity to applaud all of our younger citizens for taking part in the Remembrance Day Services and the Annual Parade, and for the respect they showed to those in the parade who were fortunate to return from conflict, and their thoughtful words at the Children's Service in memory of those who did not. **WITHOUT EXCEPTION, the Town of Brigg and your parents should be justifiably proud of each and every one of you.***
