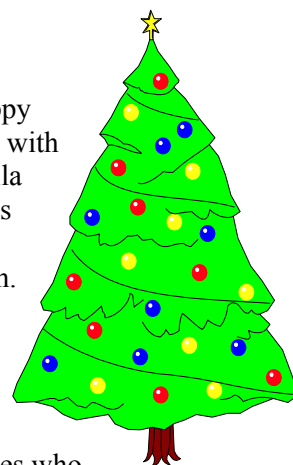

As I begin to write this Christmas Greeting, I am in the midst of the run up to the Annual Poppy Appeal and preparing for Remembrance Day and I am therefore absolutely delighted to share with you the news that I was recently invited to attend a Presentation of Awards to receive the Stella Willing Trophy. This trophy, which is now on display in the window of Pailthorp Jewellers, is awarded to the Poppy Appeal Organiser of a village or small town in Lincolnshire, who has achieved the most improved amount collected without the support of the Royal British Legion. Needless to say, I was pleased to receive the Stella Willing Trophy, not only for myself, but also for my excellent team of collectors, without whom the fantastic sum of £5,859.38 could not have been raised in 2005.



November reminds us all how lucky we are to live in a peaceful and pleasant Market Town in North Lincolnshire, but we must not forget that there are many members of our armed forces who will not be home for Christmas, and our thoughts are with them and their families in these troubled times. It therefore gives me even greater pleasure to announce that the fantastic sum of £5,817.18 has been raised in Brigg, for the 2006 Poppy Appeal.
