Annual Meeting

Following the un-contested election, the Town Council held its first Annual Meeting of the new four year term, on Monday 21st May 2007, but before the meeting commenced, Councillor Maureen Glossop asked everyone in attendance to observe a one minute silence in memory of Councillor Dick Long who sadly died a few weeks ago.

Councillor Long was the Ward Councillor for the North Lincolnshire Council Brigg and Wold Ward, and also served on the old Glanford Borough Council.

Stepping down from the office of Town Mayor, Councillor Maureen Glossop advised the Town Council that she had experienced a most enjoyable year, and received a warm welcome at all of the events she had attended.

Councillor Glossop presented cheques to her two chosen charities, Brigg L.I.V.E.S. First Responders and Friends of Brigg County Primary School for £1,665.00 each, from the proceeds of her Town Mayor's Appeal.

Councillor Mike Doherty was installed as the new Town Mayor of Brigg, and will be supported during his Mayoral Year by his wife Pat as the Lady Mayoress. Father Owain Mitchell will be his Chaplain.

The Town Mayor's Appeal for 2007-2008 will be in aid of Local Hospice Care, for which donations and offers to help with fundraising activities will be gratefully received.

Thanks were extended to long standing Councillors who have recently retired from Office, for all their hard work and service to the Town. Mike Birkitt, Tony Morris, Adele Tasker and Tony Sykes.

At the start of the meeting, the three vacant seats were to be filled by co-option. As a result of advertising in the local press, six applications by interested persons had been forthcoming and the council voted openly for three of these.

Unfortunately, the meeting was not very well attended by the general public, which was extremely regrettable, as representatives of the many organisations who serve the needs of the older members of the community had attended to give presentations on the work that they do. However, literature has been left at the Town Council Office should anyone wish to learn more about the services available.

The issue of the increase in freight traffic along the railway line through Brigg was raised by a resident, and the Town Council is currently awaiting a reply from Network Rail regarding this issue, which has also been raised with Ian Cawsey MP.

The issue of maintaining the footpath to the railway station was also raised, and North Lincolnshire Council will be meeting with Network Rail, regarding this matter, in the near future.

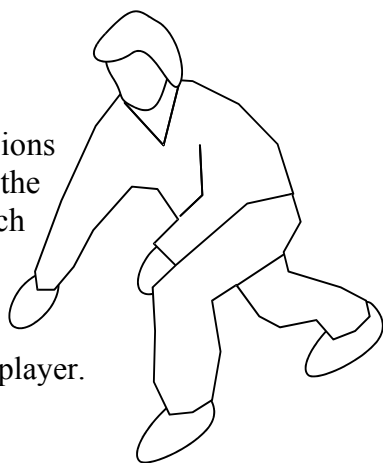
Princess Diana Plaque

Judging will soon be underway for the Best Kept Garden and the Prize Allotment Award, when every front garden and every allotment is judged.



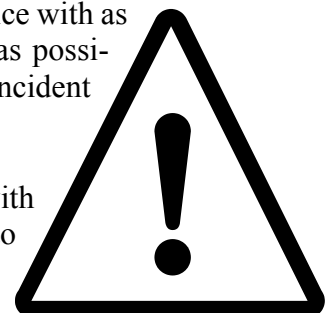
Members of the Town Council will also be considering the Annual Civic Award.
