#### **BRIGG TOWN COUNCIL : ANNUAL MEETING 2008**

The Town Council Annual Meeting was held on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May.

Before handing over the Chain of Office, Councillor Mike Doherty thanked members for the honour of serving as Town Mayor, and advised that he and his wife, Pat, as Lady Mayoress felt very privileged to have been given the opportunity to meet so many hard working members of the community throughout the Mayoral Year.

Councillor Doherty presented cheques for the sum of £1,711.66 to his two chosen charities, The Lindsey Lodge Hospice, and the St. Andrew's Childrens Hospice.

Councillor Mike Campion was installed as the new Town Mayor of Brigg, and will be supported during his Mayoral Year by his wife Ann as the Lady Mayoress. Father Owain Mitchell will be his Chaplain.

The Town Mayor's Appeal for 2008-2009 will be in aid of Macmillan Cancer Relief and the Brigg and District Breast Cancer Support Group, for which donations and offers to help with fundraising activities will be gratefully received.

The Deputy Town Mayor / Mayor Elect is Councillor James Truepenny. He will be supported by Councillor E.G.R. Arnott, as the Town Mayor's Consort.

#### **Brigg Ambulance Service**

Having been alerted to the fact that changes were proposed to the type and level of service that would be provided for Brigg and its neighbours, the Town Council called upon the Ambulance Service to explain the lack of public consultation afforded. It has since been involved in the Scrutiny Process through North Lincolnshire Council, and has also been involved in a meeting called by Ian Cawsey MP.

The Town Council will continue to monitor the service provided, but members are heavily reliant on feedback from the general public – as the end user.

Details of your experiences (good and bad) would be gratefully received.

#### **Remembrance Sunday**

After a great deal of consultation, thought, and consideration, the Town Council has decided that it will not change the timing of the Annual Remembrance Sunday Parade and Service.

It will, however, make every effort to increase the publicity running up to Remembrance Sunday, in order to ensure that the general public are fully aware of the time for the wreath laying at the War Memorial

### Annual Awards

Judging will soon be underway for the Best Kept Garden and the Prize Allotment Award, when every front garden and every allotment is judged.

Members of the Town Council will also be considering the Annual Civic Award.

### 3B's Youth Street Project

Staff have now been appointed, and the project is moving very quickly toward the launch of activity sessions out in the three parishes of Brigg, Barnetby-le-Wold and Broughton.

### Planning Matters

Residents who have any concerns regarding Planning Applications in their area are urged to make the Town Council aware of them, and to copy any written responses to the Town Council Office, for members attention.

Unless the Town Council is made aware of your concerns, members may be unaware that the application submitted will cause you a problem.

### Application to erect dwellings on the Glebe Road School Site

A very useful meeting was held with Mr P. Scott, the Highway Safety Officer, regarding the application received, and the concerns raised by residents through members of the Town Council were discussed.

Not surprisingly, the majority of the concerns raised focused on the issue of traffic, and the fact that the traffic calming measures installed on Glebe Road are still causing problems.

The Town Council has therefore placed a formal request before North Lincolnshire Council to re-visit the traffic calming measures on Glebe Road, and to undertake any surveys in the evening, as well as at varying hours of the day.

Concerns with regard to the impact on the drainage system in this area, as well as the problems envisaged with construction traffic were also voiced.

### Application to erect 60 dwellings on Land off Island Carr Road, Brigg

The Town Council has re-iterated its previous concerns regarding residential development proposals in this area of the Town, namely related to traffic congestion, drainage and flooding, and it has also recommended to North Lincolnshire Council that a more detailed design brief should be drawn up for the whole area before this application is progressed any further.

### Police Matters

The Town Council continues to work very closely with the Local Policing Team, and is very much aware that there are still spates of vandalism by a small minority of people intent on spoiling the appearance of the Town.
