BRIGG COMMUNITY EMERGENCY PLAN COMMUNITY RESPONSE

The snow and sub-zero temperatures experienced in December 2010, highlighted the need for a co-ordinated Community Response Team that could be tasked with ensuring that all members of the community are safe and well, and to carry out small but important tasks, such as collecting shopping for those members of the community who are less able.

With your support, this type of response team can be integrated into the Brigg Town Council Community Emergency Plan, but help will be needed from all areas of the Town in order to achieve that aim.

Put very simply – it is suggested that the Town could be divided up into manageable 'community areas' (in much the same way as a 'Neighbourhood Watch' scheme would operate). Each area would then have its own designated team of volunteers who could be called upon to help their friends and neighbours should a significant issue arise that interrupts normal daily life.

Brigg Town Council would welcome your opinion on this important issue; therefore, it will be on the agenda for discussion at the forthcoming Annual Town Meeting.

Please come along - air your views – and perhaps volunteer.
